Sarawak 4D3N Kuching Wildlife & Bako National Park

DAY 1: KUALA LUMPUR > KUCHING > CITY & SHOPPING TOUR

Welcome to **Kuching International Airport**. Meet & greet on arrival by our local representative and for **Kuching City & Shopping Tour**. Kuching, the Capital of Sarawak, is a cosmopolitan city and this is reflected in the faces on the street. Its city center is well preserved with ornate Chinese Temples, The Astana, City Tower, and many fine examples of colonial-style architecture, a beautiful waterfront and a number of interesting museums such as Cat Museum. Other places of interest include the famous landmark of the city, the New DUN, The Golden Bridge, The Cat



Monument, Market, Main Bazaar, China Town, Old State Mosque & etc. After tour, transfer to hotel of your choice for check-in and rest of the day at your own leisure & expense.

DAY 2: KUCHING ➤ SEMENGGOH WILDLIFE CENTRE ➤ CROCODILE FARM ➤ RIVER CRUISE (Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning proceed to visit Semenggoh Wildlife Centre, traveling overland (30 mins) and



follow by a brief hike through dipterocarp forest. Upon arrival at the centre, you will be able to catch a glimpse of the Orang Utan during their feeding time. Spot their delicate nests watch their skillful movements at the treetops and also their interesting behaviour during feeding time. The guide will narrate to you the behavio ur, emotion and characteristics of this special primate called Orang Utan, meaning 'Man of the Forest'. Continue the journey to visit **Crocodile Farm & Mini Zoo**. The farm set

amidst tropical fruit trees and lush-greenery is a home to over 1,000 crocodiles. It serves as a perfect sanctuary to these fearsome reptiles where they are kept in an enclosure designed and built similar to the natural habitat of the reptiles. Apart from the crocodiles, explore the farm where other fascinating animals such as the bear cats, civets, deer, pythons & etc are found in the state of Sarawak. Evening, proceed for **Sarawak River Cruise**.

A cruise along the Sarawak River is a relaxing way to enjoy the various phases of the city and retrace the trip James Brooke made when he first arrived in Sarawak. You will sail past the Waterfront, Brooke Dockyard, the 100-year-old Malay Kampung, Fort Margherita, Astana, Square Tower and the Industrial Estate. As you sail toward the sea colourful fishing boats will appear in abound and nearby Bako after the Chinese and Malay villages are the houses and mansions of Kuching's affluent society. The constant changing of this living scenery gives you the best picture of the history and lifestables in Kuching. lifestyles in Kuching. After tour, transfer back to the hotel and rest of the day at your own leisure & expense.

DAY 03: KUCHING > BAKO NATIONAL PARK (Breakfast/Lunch)

Breakfast at the hotel. Then proceed for **Bako National Park Tour.** Bako National Park, established since 1957, is the oldest and one of the most popular national parks in Sarawak. Situated about 37 km from Kuching city, the excursion takes about one and a half hour by land and boat. With an area about 2,727 hectares, it offers the perfect introduction to Sarawak's Forest and wildlife. Unlike the other parks, visitors to Bako National Park are almost guaranteed to see wildlife such as long-tailed macaques, squirrels, white bearded pigs, silver leaf monkeys, etc. With 17



trails provided, ranging from 0.2 km to 5.75 km, you will almost find new experience in each different trail. You will be brought along the Teluk Paku trail. To spot the Proboscis monkey, species which only can be found in Borneo Island, you will need to walk slowly, keep as quiet as possible, and listen out for sounds and movement along the way. In Bako National Park, you will also be able to view 7 different types of vegetation and forests from almost desert-like scrub or 'padang' to lowland dipterocarp forest. Lunch at Bako Park café. After tour, transfer back to the hotel and rest of the day at your own leisure & expense.

The guides will do their utmost to ensure a sighting, but cannot be held responsible if there is no success, because of weather circumstances, the wildlife itself or any other element beyond our control.

After breakfast at hotel, free time at your own leisure until the transfer (Seat-in-Coach basis) to **Kuching International Airport** for your flight back home.
