Sightseeing

End Overnight

Explore Fiery Madrid Join your *Local Specialist* on this day of discovery, including views of the iconic Cibeles fountain and Paseo de la Castellana. Admire the Royal Palace and Retiro Park before spending the rest of the day on your own indulging in la buena vida. (B)

Onwards to Toledo and Granada Join your Local Specialist for a walking tour of Toledo, during which you'll visit the Church of Santo Tomé. Dive Into Culture at a local steel and Damascene workshop, before your journey continues to Granada. (B, D, 🐠) Hotel: Occidental

Cross the Strait of Gibraltar to Tangier Cross to North Africa by ferry, arriving in Tangier, the gateway to Morocco.
