Sabah 4D3N Naturally & Kota Kinabalu Tour

TOUR CODE: BKI4DNAT (Validity: Until 31 December 2022)

DAY 1: KUALA LUMPUR > KOTA KINABALU (Lunch)

Welcome to **Kota Kinabalu International Airport.** (Preferably flight arrives by 1100). Meet & greet on arrival by our local representative and transfer (Seat-in coach basis) to local restaurant for lunch. After lunch, proceed with **Kota Kinabalu City Tour** to see famed landmarks and attractions of Kota Kinabalu City, the capital of Sabah.

Tun Mustapha Tower – formerly known as the Sabah Foundation Building, it was renamed to Tun Mustapha Tower after the first former Chief Minister of Sabah. The 30-storey high circular glass building stands on a central core with steel brackets supporting each floor. When



completed in 1977, it was one of the 3 building on the world built on this unique design concept.

Blue City Mosque – Marvel at the sight of the beautiful city mosque, designed after the Nabawi Mosque in Medina. The mosque sits in a man-made lagoon, earning it the nickname of "The Floating Mosque" (Optional)

Puh Toh Tze Temple – This Buddihst temple stood out with its traditional Chinese roofing and structure. The only temple in Sabah with a resting Buddha (Optional)

Sabah Handicraft Market (Filipino Market) –Check out the bustling collection of colourful stalls selling local souvenirs and handicrafts, decorative items, clothing and accessories.

Snacks & Dried Seafood Market – Adjacent to the Sabah Handicraft Market is the snacks market where you will find a variety of local snacks including the famous fish cracker 'Amplang Ikan' and Kuih Cincin. No visit to the market is complete without stopping by at the dried seafood market where you will find freshly dried shrimps, anchovies, sea cucumbers, scallops and more. (Any shopping at your own expense).

After city tour, check-in at the hotel and the rest of the day is free time at your own leisure.

DAY 2: KOTA KINABALU > KUNDASANG > KOTA KINABALU (Breakfast/Lunch)

0715 - Depart to Kundasang. Enjoy scenic view of the quaint countryside, the majestic **Mount Kinabalu**, dreamy valleys and colourful roadside farmer markets as you drive along the **Crocker Range**. Short stop at **Nabalu Market** for photo opportunity and to explore the local market place. Next visit **Desa Dairy Farm**. Dubbed the New Zealand of Sabah, the rolling green pasture with grazing cows at foothill of Mt Kinabalu is a sight to behold. The 199 hectares' farm produces over 2 million litres of high quality milk per year from the Holstein -Friesian cows. Try the fresh milk and soft ice-cream while you are here (own expense).



Next, visit **Poring Hot Springs**. Trek through the rainforest trail to the **canopy walkway**. Three circuits of suspension bridge zigzag through the crowns of the tallest and strongest rainforest trees with a total length of

373.6 meters and height up to 41 meters above ground offering good




opportunity to observe canopy-dwelling rainforest inhabitants such as butterflies, insects, tree shrews, squirrels and birds. If time permits, stop by **Kinabalu National Park**, Malaysia's first UNESCO's World Heritage Site for a drive through and photo-shot opportunity. Then transfer to



back to Kota Kinabalu and rest of the day at your own leisure & expense.

DAY 3: KOTA KINABALU > ISLAND HOPPING > KOTA KINABALU (Breakfast/Packed Lunch)

After breakfast at hotel, morning transfer to the jetty for a boat ride to the idyllic Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park cluster of tropical islands. Swim and snorkel in the crystal blue sea or just relax on the sandy beach. Snorkeling gears and packed lunch are provided. After lunch, depart to the next tropical island for more fun in the sun. Plenty of sea sports such as banana boat, jet ski, sea walking and parasailing are available for your enjoyment (own expense and advisable to pre-booked).
