## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### BALI

- ◆ **Garuda Wisnu Kencana** - Enjoy the true Balinese cultural experience and the splendor of the fourth tallest statue in the world, the Garuda Wisnu Kencana Statue. Designed by renowned Balinese artist Nyoman Nuarta, this statue is made of copper and brass and has 754 modules with 25 steel segments weighing 900 tons, with a steel weight of 1300 tons. The statue and its pedestal are 120.9 meters high and 64 meters wide thanks to the wingspan of Garuda. In addition to the statue, GWK also provides many other tourist areas, ranging from dance performance areas, parks, and outdoor activities, to typical photo spots.
- ◆ **Pandawa Beach** - Pandawa Beach is one of the many hidden beaches of Bali. Pandawa Beach also features milky-colored sands accompanied by clear blue waters going on an ebb and flow, suitable for those who crave a calming atmosphere while basking in the warmth of the radiant sun. Those who love a little bit of adventure can also partake in some recreational activities such as canoeing, snorkeling, surfing, or paragliding.
- ◆ **Ulun Danu Beratan Temple** - Ulun Danu was built in adoration of the Goddess Danu. Danu, in the Balinese tongue, means lake, while the goddess Danu is queen of water, lakes and rivers. The temple complex consists of four sacred buildings. The style of the building follows the Trimurti belief; three holy colors to represent the three gods: Shiva, Brahma and Vishnu.
- ◆ **Wanagiri Hidden Hill** - has a lot selfie spots, each location has different attractions, from its beautiful human-sized bird's nest, swing, wooden teacups, the bow of a boat, wooden stars, tree houses, an Indonesian interpretation of the Eiffel Tower and much more. All of these platforms face directly to Lake Buyan and Lake Tamblingan surrounded by shady forests and is a truly beautiful bite of Bali.
- ◆ **Tanah Lot Temple** - built by one of the last priests to come to Bali from Java in the 16th century, its rituals include the paying of homage to the guardian spirits of the sea.
- ◆ **Krisna Oleh-oleh** - Krisna is the biggest souvenir shop in Bali, they even claim to be the biggest in South-East Asia. There are many Krisna stores all over the island, in Kuta, Denpasar and even in Singaraja. They sell all types of typically Bali merchandises from clothes, foods, toys, spa products, arts and anything you can think of. All items are available on fixed price.

### NUSA PENIDA

- ◆ **Kelingking Beach** - An incredible hidden beach framed by towering, steep cliffs, and deep turquoise blue waters further embraced by powdery white sand with the most amazing view like heaven on earth. The secluded beach itself is down a rugged 400m cliffside hike. From this viewpoint, visitors look down onto the white sand enveloped by the famous limestone headland that reaches out into the Indian Ocean.
- ◆ **Diamond Beach** - Diamond Beach Nusa Penida is one of the best beaches on the island. The shiny white sand and turquoise water make this a must-see destination on the Nusa Islands. This place is also becoming popular where you can take pictures while swinging between two palm trees over the beach.
