# **TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:**

### TAOYUAN

- **ZhongLi Night Market -** There are everything to eat, drink and play. The first half is mainly Hong Kong & Korean style clothing, daily necessities, leisure and entertainment; the second half is a paradise of food, many well-known stalls and delicious Taiwanese foods.
- **Matsu New Village Cultural and Creative Park -** Matsu New Village, which enjoys the reputation of "Taoyuan General Village", is not named because the local residents come from Matsu, but when President Chiang's wife Soong Meiling led the labor regiment to Matsu to offer condolences, in order to stabilize the hearts of the army and put forward the need to resettle the dependents of these officers and soldiers stationed on the front line in Taiwan. the current Matsu New Village was built.

### **HSINCHU**

**Beipu Old Street** - Located in Beipu Township, Hsinchu, its block belongs to the scope of "Beipu Old Settlement", including Beipu Street, Temple Street, Nanxing Street, Chengmen Street, etc. There are Jin Guang Fu Hall, Tienshuei Hall, Jiang A-Sin Ancient House, Beipu Citian Temple, Beipu Zhongshu Hall and other historical sites in the block, which is a famous tourist attraction in Hsinchu County.

## TAICHUNG

- Gaomei Wetlands It is rich in natural resources and has a complex ecological species, mainly birds, fish, crabs and other invertebrates. , is an important ecological conservation area.
- **LALAPORT** Located in the East District of Taichung City, close to the Taiwan Sugar Ecological Lakeside Park, in addition to retaining the old Taiwan Sugar Factory with historical and cultural value, after the renovation of integrating nature and water sources, it is a new landscape green park integrating modernity and history in Taichung District. The whole building is divided into two buildings, the [North Building] and the [South Building], which brings together Japanese large supermarkets and well-known large-scale clothing and daily necessities brands. Food street, etc. In particular, the gathering of Japanese daily necessities brands is a highlight. The planning and circulation of the [North Building] are in the middle. Small, and diverse brands gather. The South Pavilion focuses on exotic cuisine, while the North Pavilion focuses on Japanese cuisine, allowing everyone to have a variety of choices and challenge their taste buds on multiple levels.
- **Noodles Origin -** The family has been making noodles for more than 80 years since 1934, and in 2006, he founded the "Daxia Noodle Honka" brand to add traditional noodles to cultural creativity. With more than 80 years of noodle making technology and cultural heritage, the Daxia noodle family has selected the champion taro into the noodles in line with the promotion of Taichung Dajia's local culture, creating Taiwan's first taro noodles. Daxia Noodles allows customers to eat noodles while not only getting more healthy nutrients, but more importantly, conveying the noodles and the brand's heritage and story to everyone at the same time.

### TAIPEI

RongJin Gorgeous Time - it is a newly renovated Japanese-style park in Taipei. It gathers 14 brands, including Xingbo Coffee, Haoqiu, and Kyushu Muffins. It is the latest super popular check-in spot.
