DUBAI

- **Burj Al Arab** – this uniquely styled hotel is Dubai's landmark. It has been called "The world's only 7 star hotel" and it is one of the tallest hotels in the world. Burj Al Arab stands on an artificial island that is 280 m (920 ft) from Jumeirah beach and is connected to the mainland by a private curving bridge. It looks like a wind-swept sail and is the most extravagant representative of the UAE.
- **The Palm Jumeirah** – is the world's largest artificial island, it forms by three planned islands (Palm Jumeirah, Jebel Ali and Palm Deira). The sky is overlooked by the shape of a palm tree. Therefore, it is called the eight wonders of the world.
- **Burj Khalifa** – formerly known as Burj Dubai is located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates territory of skyscrapers is currently the world's tallest man-made structures with a height of 828 m, total 169 floors, cost up to \$ 1.5 billion.
- **Dhow Dinner Cruise** – a Dhow Cruise with a different scenery! A Cruise on board the traditional Arabian Dhow in the heart of "New Dubai". The Dubai Marina is a canal city in the Venetian tradition, carved along a two mile stretch of Persian Gulf shoreline.
- **Bedouin Campsite** – desert camping in a Bedouin camp is an experience that every traveler should try at least once because you will feel closer to the landscape and the people. Instead of walking into a hotel lobby, walk into our beautiful belt shar tents, nestled in the rocks of Little Petra.

ABU DHABI

- **Sheikh Zayed Mosque** – also known as the Abu Dhabi Grand Mosque. It used 46 tons of gold. The giant carpets and crystal-plated chandeliers in the temple are among the best in the world. The pure white dome of the sheikh Zayed Mosque has 82 domes and tour 107-meter-high minarets.
- **Yas Island** – the island is home to the Ferrari World Theme Park in Abu Dhabi, including Water Park Hotel, Shopping Center, Movie Theme Park, Golf Course, Apartments, Villas and Restaurants.
- **Ferrari World** – it is the first Ferrari-branded theme park, also home to the world's fastest rollercoaster. Formula Rossa, this is the only place on the planet where you can be blasted to 240km/h in 4.9 seconds, providing endless entertainment and adventures for visitors of all ages.
- **Emirates Palace** – an iconic Abu Dhabi landmark, this beautiful hotel blends Arabian splendour with the latest luxuries to create a magical and memorable experience. The hotel features 114 domes, gold, mother of pearl and crystals dominate the interior. Guests and visitors can wander through the majestic halls and corridors – a showcase of Arabian design, with grand central passageways and arched ceilings.
