**Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine** (80 mins)

One of the most popular shrine with a path of over 5000 orange torii gates, this shrine was dedicated to the god of rice and sake in the 8<sup>th</sup> century.

**Kiyomizudera Temple & Lunch** (100 mins)

This temple was founded 778 and built without a single nail in the entire Structure, dedicated to the deity of love and match-making.

**Kinkakuji Temple** (45 mins)

Also known as the Golden Pavilion. This temple was built in late 14th century and retains a perfect feature of Zen Temple to modern days.

**Arashiyama** (80 mins)

Green and lush bamboo forest & Togetsukyo Bridge.

1830: Namba OCAT. (Drop-off Point)

1915: Hearton Hotel Nishi Umeda. (Drop-off Point)
