**Arashiyama** (120 mins including Lunch)

The "Moon Crossing Bridge - Togetsukyo, notable for its views of cherry blossoms and autumn colours on the slopes of Arashiyama.

**Kinkakuji Temple** (45 mins)

Also known as the Golden Pavilion. This temple was built in late 14<sup>th</sup> century and retains a perfect feature of Zen Temple to modern days).

**Nara Park** (90 mins)

A public park located in the city of Nara where 1,200 wild sika deer freely roaming around in the park).

1740: **Namba OCAT.** (Drop-off Point)

1810: **Hearton Hotel Nishi Umeda.** (Drop-off Point)
