## **NAGANO**

- ◆ Jigokudani Yaen Koen Garden Located in the mountains of Nagano Prefecture, Japan, in a steep valley where hot water gushes from the ground and hot steam fills the air, the area is called Hell Valley. After the Japanese macaque conservation area was established here in 1964, many monkeys gathered. The monkeys in this area started to imitate humans by soaking in hot springs, and after generations of passing down this behaviour, it has become a habit of the monkeys in this area. They are also the only monkeys in the world with the habit of soaking in hot springs.
- ◆ Zenkoji With a history of about 1,400 years, the temple enshrines Japan's oldest Buddha statue. It has been renowned throughout Japan since ancient times, and there is even a saying: "No matter how far, you must visit Zenko-ji Temple at least once.
- Kumoba Pond Located in Karuizawa, one of Japan's premier highland resorts, the serene lake is a classic sightseeing spot. In the early days, when the area was a villa district for foreigners, swans would fly in during the winter, hence it is also known as "Swan Lake.

#### **YAMANASHI**

 Oshino Hakkai - is a scenic spot in Japan's Fuji Five Lakes region, consisting of eight crystal-clear springs. Forming eight beautiful ponds, known as the "Eight Springs of Oshino," it stands as a local natural attraction.

### **TOKYO**

- ◆ Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple) Is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- Shinjuku Centered around the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building and a street lined with skyscrapers and office buildings, Shinjuku is known for its shopping and entertainment facilities. At its heart lies Kabukicho, renowned as the city that never sleeps, making it one of Japan's rare entertainment districts.


