TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple) - Is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.

- Jigokudani Yaen Koen Garden There is the only hot spring in the world dedicated to wild monkeys. To get to Jigokudani Monkey Park, you must walk through a forest for about 1.6 kilometers. Hiking in the valley forest is also a highlight. You can smell the fragrance of the trees and the fresh air along the way, making the walk very relaxing. After the establishment of the Japanese Macaque Conservation Area in 1964, many monkeys gathered here. The monkeys imitated humans by taking hot spring baths, and this behavior became a habit for the monkeys in this area after being passed down from generation to generation.
- **Zenkoji** With a history of about 1,400 years, the temple enshrines Japan's oldest Buddha statue. It has been renowned throughout Japan since ancient times, and there is even a saying: "No matter how far, you must visit Zenko-ji Temple at least once.

SHIRAKAWA-GO

Shirakawa-go Village - the Historic Villages of Shirakawa-go are one of Japan's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These villages are well known for their houses constructed in the architectural style known as gash O-zukuri. The Gasshō-zukuri, "prayer-hands construction" style is characterized by a thatched and steeply slanting roof resembling two hands joined in prayer. The design is exceptionally strong and, in combination with the unique properties of the thatching, allow the houses to withstand and shed the weight of the region's heavy snowfalls in winter.

KYOTO

Kiyomizu Temple - is renowned for its construction which uses no nails to support the elaborate wooden structure of the main hall. And with a quaint old lane lined with pottery shops lead up to this famous temple.
