TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

YAMANASHI

- ◆ **Oshino Hakkai** - is a scenic spot in Japan's Fuji Five Lakes region, consisting of eight crystal-clear springs. Forming eight beautiful ponds, known as the "Eight Springs of Oshino," it stands as a local natural attraction.
- ◆ **Lake Kawaguchi** - is the northernmost of the Fuji Five Lakes and is administratively part of Fujikawaguchiko Town in Minamitsuru County in the southeastern part of Yamanashi Prefecture .

TOKYO

- ◆ **Shibuya Crossing** - is one of Tokyo's iconic sights, and has appeared countless times in movies, magazines, and blogs. During the busiest hours, around 1,000 to 2,500 people cross the intersection every 2 minutes, enough to quickly fill a football field.
- ◆ **Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple)** - The temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- ◆ **Shinjuku** - Centered around the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building and a street lined with skyscrapers and office buildings, Shinjuku is known for its shopping and entertainment facilities. At its heart lies Kabukicho, renowned as the city that never sleeps, making it one of Japan's rare entertainment districts.
- ◆ **Ginza** - is a commercial district in Chuo-ku, Tokyo , Japan . It is known for its internationally renowned department stores, boutiques, restaurants and cafes, and is one of Tokyo's most representative areas. It is considered one of the most expensive and luxurious bustling areas in the world. In the past, it formed the core of Shitamachi together with Nihonbashi and Kanda .

YOKOHAMA

- ◆ **Yokohama Yamashita Park** - Yamashita Park is a seaside park that was opened in 1930 as a reconstruction project after the Great Kanto Earthquake, using rubble and other materials to reclaim land from the sea.
- ◆ **Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse** - The Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse is one of the main attractions of the Port of Yokohama. Originally the main cargo distribution center of Yokohama, the warehouse has now become a thriving cultural center for the local community.
