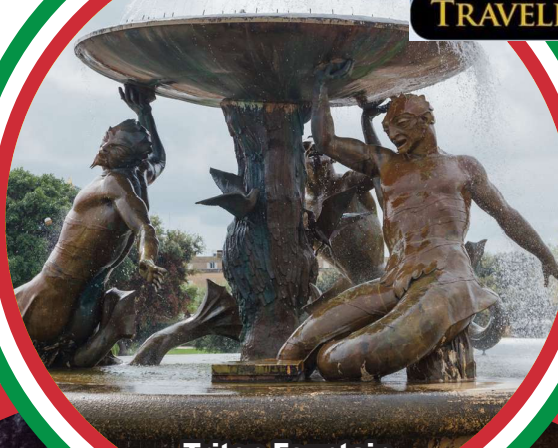

LIMASSOL

- **Hala Sultan Tekke Mosque** - is located on the west bank of the Salt Lake and was erected over different phases, commencing from 1760 and completed in 1817. It is an important Islamic monument, one of the most revered sites in the Muslim world and it is used to this day for religious purposes. The mosque was built over the grave of Umm Haram or Ummü Haram, who was believed to be the sister of the Prophet Mohammed's foster mother or a follower from Medina to Cyprus.

TROODOS

- **Kykkos Monastery** - was founded around the end of the 11th century by the Byzantine emperor Alexios I Komnenos (1081–1118). The monastery lies at an altitude of 1318m on the north west face of Troödos Mountains. There are no remains of the original monastery as it was burned down many times.

VALLETTA

- **Triton Fountain** - it was designed by Vincent Apap. The fountain is a stunning landmark where located at the outside of the City Gate of Valletta and depicts three bronze Tritons (mythological sea gods) holding up a large basin. It serves as a central point in the city and is a symbol of Malta's connection to the sea and its rich cultural heritage.
- **St. John's Co Cathedral** - was built in a stunning Baroque-style and was built by the Knights of St. John between 1572 and 1577, following the Great Siege of Malta in 1565. The cathedral is located in the heart of Valletta, the capital city of Malta. It is one of the most important religious and historical landmarks on the island.

BIRGU

- **Cinque Terre Birgu Old Town** - also known as Vittoriosa, Birgu is a fortified city located in the southeastern part of Malta, overlooking the Grand Harbour. It is one of the oldest and most historic cities on the island and served as the capital of Malta during the rule of the Knights of St. John in the 16th century.
- **Collachio** - one of the oldest part of the city. It was characterized by narrow winding streets and traditional Maltese architecture. It's a charming area to explore, filled with centuries-old buildings, quaint courtyards and hidden gems waiting to be discovered around every corner.

TAORMINA

- **Corso Umberto** - is Taormina's main street, begins at Piazza IX Aprile and then crosses the town before ending at Porta Catania. The entire street, with its squares and terraces, shops and open-air cafés seems made for sauntering and stopping to savor the views of Mt. Etna and the sea.

ALBEROBELLO

- **Trulli of Alberobello** - is a town that is famous for her distinctive and evocative local architecture, characterized by the presence of trulli. A traditional limestone building from the area that features cone-shaped or domed roofs made of corbelled slabs of stone has been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1996.

MATERA

- **Sassi di Matera** - are two districts of the Italian city of Matera, Basilicata, well-known for their ancient cave dwellings inhabited since the Paleolithic period. Along with the park of the Rupestran Churches, it was named a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1993.

AMALFI

- **Amalfi Coast** - the town that gives its name to the coast, earning it nick name "Divine Coast", one of the most popular destinations of the world's jet set. At the center of the main square there is the beautiful Cathedral of St. Andrew, with its impressive staircase, the bell-tower in Arab-Norman style and the charming Cloister of Paradise.

CAPRI ISLAND

- **Blue Grotto** - Hop on Board the Hydrofoil to Isle of Capri. Visit the most famous sight on Capri, Blue Grotto. Entrance to Blue Grotto is only possible travelling by wooden rowboat and enjoy a picturesque ride. With aquamarine water of the ocean, the island's dramatic coastline and the rugged landscapes plunging into the sparkling water, the view when on the boat is truly mesmerizing. (Blue Grotto visit also subject to weather, the sea level condition and winter season from Nov to Dec. Alternative, it will be replaced to enjoy the captivating views of Anacapri)

NAPLES

- **Castel Nuovo** - better known as Maschio Angioino, is a medieval and Renaissance castle built at the behest of Charles I of Anjou in 1266, after defeating the Swabians, ascending the throne of Sicily and moving the capital from Palermo to Naples. In the 15th century, the castle was extensively renovated to its present form after it was conquered by the king of Aragon. The castle houses the Civic Museum and the library of the Neapolitan Society of Homeland History.
- **Piazza del Plebiscito** - It was named after the referendum that pulled Naples into the unification of Italy in 1860. The bold square stands as a symbol of a rejuvenated Naples, reinvented to crown its historic landmarks. The four buildings that surround the Piazza del Plebiscito include the Royal Palace, the Basilica of St. Francis of Paola, and the Prefecture and the Palace of Salerno, two symmetrical buildings that bring harmony to the place.
