TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

NOBORIBETSU

- Noboribetsu Jigokudani Is a spectacular, appropriately named valley just above the town of Noboribetsu Onsen, which displays hot steam vents, sulfurous streams and other volcanic activity.
- Mt. Showa-Shinzan Literally means 'Showa new mountain, as it formed during the reign of Emperor Hirohito, known as the Showa period.
- Bear Ranch Around 100 Ezo brown bears in the park. When you feed with apple, the big brown bears will stand up together and make "give me" poses, which are very popular among the visitors.

HAKODATE

- Goryökaku Park The Site of Goryokaku Fort, designated as a national special historic site, is a park blessed with nature. You can enjoy walking around through beautiful scenery in four seasons: Cherry blossoms in spring, green trees in summer, autumn leaves in fall and snow in winter.
- ◆ Hakodate Night View Ranks with Hong Kong and Naples as one of the most stunning night view in the world. Awarded the highest rating of three stars in the "Michelin Green Guide Japon", the view from Mt. Hakodate is described as "worth taking time out to see." Tourists from around the world flock to Mt. Hakodate throughout the year.

OTARU

- Otaru Canal Rows of old warehouse built of stone stand along the canal. There
 is a stone-paved promenade and the old fashioned gas lamps are lit and provide a
 romantic atmosphere.
- Sakaimachi Street Is an attractive, preserved merchant street in central Otaru, and famous with Kitaichi Glass and Music Box Museum.

SAPPORO

- ◆ Shiroi Koibito Park (Chocolate Factory) Is a fantastic space based on the ideals of deliciousness, fun and stories of sweets from a bygone era. In addition to housing the Shiroi Koibito Factory where this well-known Hokkaido Confectionery is produced the park also has a café to allow visitors to try Ishiya's Original sweets, the Cookiescarft Studio, a toy exhibition room and the Rose Garden, the place visitors see, taste and experience here will make for truly "sweet memories"!
- ◆ Hokkaido Shrine In 1869 the Meiji Emperor decided to enshrine three Shinto Deities: Sukunahikon a, Ookunitama and Ookuninushi. They became the three deities of Hokkaido. The building for the shrine was built in 1871 and was called "Sapporo Shrine" The Former Hokkaido Government Building Is an American-neo-baroque structure constructed in 1888 as a base of the Hokkaido administration, It is the symbol of Hokkaido.
- Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade Approximately 1KM- long arcade with around 200 shops that provide you a great shopping experie
