- ♦ Mirror Stone Cave Mirror stone cave is a cave or tunnel located in a rock hill in West Manggarai, Flores, East Nusa Tenggara, Indonesia, just a few kilometers to the east of the town of Labuan Bajo. The cave earns its name from the walls that sparkle when catching the morning sun through a crevice in the roof. When we hear the word Labuan Bajo, clear turquoise water, the beauty of pink beaches, and a cluster of islands and islets will come to mind. However, how about the cave? Have you ever heard about the famous Mirror Stone Cave in Labuan Bajo? The area of Mirror Stone Cave is 19 hectares.
- ◆ Rangko Cave The Goa Rangko Cave is a neat hidden spot with a natural blue pool near the town of Labuan Bajo in Flores, Indonesia. You can swim in the pool, and it's extra easy to float because of minerals in the water. You can even spot some small fish swimming in it.
- ◆ Padar Island The Padar Island hike in Komodo has some of the most amazing views in Indonesia, and it's easy to do on a day trip from the town of Labuan Bajo. This place looks just like dinosaur country, with rocky hills and giant bays and beaches that stretch out in all directions.
- ◆ **Komodo Island** The land of dragons, unexplored marine life, and exotic beaches, Komodo island is the best kept treasure of Indonesia. Tucked away at Flores, this island is a paradise for the adventure junkies looking out for an undisturbed vacation amidst the tropical surroundings. Alongwith Rinca and Padar as neighbouring islands, this Indonesian paradise is the only place in the world to have the dinosaur-eque Komodo Dragons on land.
- ◆ Pink Long Beach Pink Beach, or Pantai Merah, as it is aptly named, is one of seven pink beaches on the planet, and is just one of the many amazing features of Komodo Island that make it truly a Natural Wonder of Nature. This exceptional beach gets its striking color from microscopic animals called Foraminifera, which produces a red pigment on the coral reefs. For this reason, it is called Red Beach in the local tongue. When the tiny fragments of red coral combine with the white sands, this produces the soft pink color that is visible along the shoreline. Aside from Pink Beach itself, a few small segments along Komodo's eastern bay also have a pinkish tint.
- ◆ Manta Point One of the famous diving sites in the Bali area is the Manta Cleaning Station on the southwest coast of Nusa Penida. Exposed site Manta Point is only accessible when conditions are favourable. Diving coral growth here is rare and the bottom consists of limestone and narrow sandy bays. Bay manta rays (manta alfredi) seek the shelter provided by bays for cleaning, socializing, and feeding when plankton gathers. In addition to the bay manta rays, blue iridescent ray fish beams, eagle beams, bamboo reef sharks, sea turtles and rat rays can also be sighted on a regular basis. Suitable for all levels of divers and snorkelers.
- ◆ Sawah Jaring Laba-Laba The shape is the tradition of the Manggarai Regency tribe. In cancar area. Otherwise, you will see the scenery of rice fields. The formation of the rice fields is similar to a spider web through the process of distribution outwards from a central point in the middle of the rice fields by traditional leaders. In this distribution process it's very fair to every family out there. The size of a land subdivision depends on one's location in the village and the number of households. The higher the position and the more family members, the more land can be obtained.
