Skyscrapers in Shinjuku (Drive-by). 

An office district lined with high-rise buildings. Feel the grandeur of the Tokyo Metropolis.

Meiji Shrine (60 mins). 

This is one of the most distinguished shrines in the country. Step inside the grounds and be surrounded by a sprawling forest which makes visitors forget about this shrine's urban location.


Japan National Stadium (Drive-by). 

Imperial Palace Plaza (40 mins). 


Admire the view at this National Garden that was formerly a private garden of the Royal Family. Enjoy the view of Nijubashi Bridge, which is said to be the face of the Imperial Palace, as well as the view of the Imperial Palace itself.

Rainbow Bridge Odaiba (drive-by). 

Cross the Rainbow Bridge.

Odaiba – Free time for sightseeing (50 mins) 

With plenty of popular sightseeing spots and large shopping facilities, this area has a lot to offer everyone from kids to adults. The Odaiba Statue of Liberty (replica), which commemorates the friendship between Japan and France, can be seen standing by the Rainbow Bridge

Lunch (60 mins). 

Savour a Western-style buffet meal.

Senso-ji Temple & Nakamise Shopping Street (50 mins). 

Senso-ji, Tokyo's oldest temple, offers plenty to see including the bright red Kaminarimon Gate, a statue of the god of thunder, and a five-story pagoda. The bustling street known as "Nakamise" stretches for about 250 m from Kaminarimon Gate to Senso-ji Temple and is filled with a plethora of shops.

Tokyo Skytree - Tenbo Deck (75 mins) 

From the observation deck of TOKYO SKYTREE®, the world's tallest free-standing broadcasting tower at 634 meters, take in the 360-degree view of Tokyo's cityscape.
