

### **TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:**

#### **NOBORIBETSU**

- Bear Ranch Around 100 Ezo brown bears in the park. When you feed with apple, the big brown bears will stand up together and make "give me" poses, which are very popular among the visitors.
- Marine Park Nixe Is a popular theme park focusing on fish, marine mammals, sea creatures and some other animals. More attractions include a touch pool with small sharks, rays, and horseshoe crabs; a reptile house with snakes, turtles and lizards. You may also have fun activities and small events like the Parade of the king penguins (Subject to weather conditions).

#### HAKODATE

- Hakodate Night View Ranks with Hong Kong and Naples as one of the most stunning night view in the world. Awarded the highest rating of three stars in the "Michelin Green Guide Japon", the view from Mt. Hakodate is described as "worth taking time out to see." Tourists from around the world flock to Mt. Hakodate throughout the year.
- Hakodate Tropical Botanical Garden s home to 3,000 tropical trees and flowers of about 300 species in the park. Another popular area is the monkey mountain. Visitors the monkey and watch the cute monkeys soaking in the hot springs during the winter season only

#### OTARU

Otaru Canal - Rows of old warehouse built of stone stand along the canal. There is a stone-paved promenade and the old fashioned gas lamps are lit and provide a romantic atmosphere.

#### SAPPORO

- Hill of the Buddha Designed by top Japanese architect Tadao Ando, this photogenic Buddha statue in a hall exudes spirituality. In keeping with Ando's mindset that "our imagination is piqued by what we cannot see," only the head is visible from a distance, prompting you to spend your trip to the site imagining what the rest might look like. Your appetite is whet with other sensory experiences along the way, including a water garden and a 40m tunnel that amplifies the sound of your footsteps. Finally, you reach a roofless hall where the 13.5m high Buddha looms over you with a snippet of sky above. This ethereal sight isn't one you'll forget easily. While you're here, you can take part in Japanese spiritual practices—write a wish on a wooden placard called an ema, find out your fortune by taking a slip of paper called an omikuji and make message lighting to express a wish. After your visit, take a moment to rest in the café in the hall.
- Moai Statue The "mo" in Moai means future and "ai" means life, and they were built to pass on your testimony to future generations forever. The largest one is 9.5m tall and weighs 120t. The others are 6.5m tall and weigh 60t. The Moai statues are lined up at the main entrance to welcome visitors.
- Hokkaido Shrine in 1869 the Meiji Emperor decided to enshrine three Shinto Deities: Sukunahikona, Ookunitama and Ookuninushi. They became the three deities of Hokkaido. The building for the shrine was built in 1871 and was called "Sapporo Shrine".
