• Koza Han - The Koza Han holds great historical significance as it dates back to the 15th century. It was originally built during the Ottoman Empire and served as a trading center and accommodation for merchants and their caravans. Today, the Koza Han continues to be a hub for silk-related activities. It houses numerous shops and stalls selling a variety of silk products, including fabrics, scarves, clothing, and accessories. Visitors have the opportunity to explore the vibrant silk market, browse the exquisite silk items, and even purchase souvenirs to take back home.
