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## Thailand 5D4N Chiangmai & Chiangrai (Overnight) Tour

### DAY 1: KUALA LUMPUR → CHIANGMAI (Lunch/Dinner)

Arrival at **Chiangmai International Airport** and welcoming by local representative. Commence city tour including **Chiangmai City Moat**, **Three Kings Monument**, and **Chedi Luang Temple**. Enjoy a local lunch at a traditional restaurant. After lunch visit to **Doi Suthep Temple**, with a cable car ride included. Next, check-in at the hotel followed by some time to relax and freshen up. In the evening, experience a **Khantoke Dinner** accompanied by a traditional Lanna style performance. Conclude the day with a return to the hotel for a well-deserved rest. **Overnight in Chiangmai.**



### DAY 2: CHIANGMAI ➤ CHIANGRAI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day with a visit to **Elephant Camp** to observe elephants showcasing their skills in log pulling and engaging in playful activities like football and harmonica performances. Enjoy a thrilling 30 minute elephant ride through the lush jungle, followed by an ox-cart ride and a serene bamboo rafting experience. Savour a diverse buffet lunch. After lunch, transfer to Chiangrai, en-route visit a **Hot Spring** for a break. Then enjoy a delightful dinner at a local restaurant. Next, visit the **Clock Tower** and discover the charm of **Chiang Rai Walking Street** where you can shop for local crafts and street food delicacies (own expenses). Conclude your day with a comfortable transfer to your hotel. **Overnight in Chiangrai.**



### DAY 3: CHIANGRAI ➤ CHIANGMAI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day with a visit to a **Long Neck Village**, where you can observe the cultural practice of women wearing brass rings around their necks. Next, travel to **Mae Sai**, Thailand's northernmost town, which is connected to Burma by a bridge. Explore the local markets in Mae Sai, offering a variety of Myanmar goods and souvenirs. Enjoy a set lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, visit the **Golden Triangle**, a region at the confluence of the Mekong and Kong Rivers, known as a historical opium-producing area. Across the border gate is between Thailand, Burma, and Laos. Continue to the **White Temple (Rong Khun Temple)**, an iconic contemporary Buddhist temple, with the entrance fee included. Then, a return trip to Chiangmai. Conclude the day with a dinner at a local restaurant in Chiangmai. **Khlong Mae Kha "Otaru" Canal Village – free add-on visit).** **Overnight in Chiangmai.**



### DAY 4: CHIANGMAI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, begin the day with a trip to **Home Industries Village** to explore various workshops and factories where artisans skilfully create traditional Thai handicrafts like Thai silk, silverware, lacquerware, jewellery and teakwood carving. Then have a lunch at a local restaurant. Next, visit **Royal Flora Garden** (include tram fee), a botanical haven spread across 80 hectares. This garden showcases a rich tapestry of flora and cultural heritage. Continue the trip to **Central Festival Shopping Mall**, where a variety of stores offer something for every shopper (expenses not included). Conclude the day with a delightful dinner at a local restaurant. **Overnight in Chiangmai..**



### DAY 5: CHIANGMAI → KUALA LUMPUR (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free and easy at own leisure until the transfer time to the airport for your departure flight.
