

#### **KEFLAVIK**

 Keflavík - is a town in the Reykjanes region in southwest Iceland. As of 2016, its population when combined with the nearby town Njarðvík, is 15,129.

#### **GOLDEN CIRCLE**

- Thingvellir National Park was founded in 1930 and was designated as a World Heritage Site in 2004. Thingvellir is the most important cultural site and one of the most popular tourist destinations in Iceland.
- Geysir Hot Springs This geothermal area is a popular stop for visitors. At this
  wonderful sight, you can wander among bubbling mud posts and steaming landscapes!
- Gullfoss Falls also known as "Golden Falls", one of Iceland's most spectacular
  waterfalls, located in the canyon of Hvítá river in southwest Iceland. Together with
  Thingvellir and the geysers, Gullfoss forms part of the Golden Circle. it's an incredible
  sight that you are not likely to forget.

#### SNAEFELLJOKULL EXCURSION

- **Gatklettur Rock** is a famous, naturally formed stone arch found between the villages of Arnarstapi and Hellnar on the Snæfellsnes Peninsula.
- Londrangar Rock Lóndrangar basalt cliffs are a pair of volcanic lava pinnacles that stick out from the sea on the coastline,
- Kirkjufellsfossar Waterfall is situated in Kirkjufellsa river at the northern side of Snaefellsnes peninsula in West Iceland. This beautiful five-meter-high fall flows in a couple of levels and is divided into three separate spouts. As you stand before the fall you will see the pyramid- shaped mount Kirkjufell towering above, one of the most scenic and beautiful in Iceland.

#### **REYKJAVIK**

Aurora Borealis - is a beautiful and mysterious natural phenomenon that occurs
when solar winds interact with the Earth's magnetic field, causing hight-energy
electrons and ions to enter the Earth's atmosphere and collide with gas molecules,
releasing energy and producing brilliant lights. The best season for the Aurora
Borealis is from Sep till Apr with the most frequent sightings occurring between 6pm

The opportunity to witness this visual wonder of nature, it is subjected on weather conditions such as solar activity, cloud cover and other factors and cannot be guaranteed. However, sighting is not confined to this schedule as the "dancing green lights" may show up randomly during your stay in Iceland.

Tour Manager will guide customer where to view the Aurora – it can be surrounding hotel area by walking distance.

Note: Aurora Borealis is a natural phenomenon, Golden Destinations unable to guarantee the appearance of during your visit at anytime.

- Hallgrimskirkja Church Reykjavik's most notable Landmarks and is the largest church in Iceland. It's 73 metres tall, and its tower can be seen from almost everywhere in the city.
- Sun Voyager Sculpture is a sculpture by Jón Gunnar Árnason, located next to the Sæbraut road in Reykjavík, Iceland. This statue is sculpted out of stainless steel, and represents a voyage following the sun.

Blue Lagoon - is the geothermal hot spring is probably the most famous in Iceland, which is a beautiful blue colour. Here you can relax all your cares away, enjoy smearing mud on your face. It is particularly convenient as its near the airport.

#### SOUTH COAST

- Seljalandsfoss Waterfall is located in south coast of Iceland. The waterfall drops 60 m and is part of the Selialands River that has its origin in the volcano glacier Eyjafjallajökull. Visitors can walk behind the falls into a small cave.
- Skogafoss Waterfall is one of the largest and most elegant waterfalls in Iceland, it has a width of 25 meters and the cascade drops 60 meters.
- Black Sand Beach is the most famous black sanded beach in Iceland and one of the most well-known in the whole world. This is a place of wild and dramatic beauty where the roaring waves of the Atlantic Ocean power ashore with tremendous force.
- Jokulsarion Glacier Lagoon is a large glacial lake in southeast iceland, and it developed into a lake after the glacier started receding from the edge of the Atlantic Ocean. The lake has grown since then at varying rates because of melting of the glaciers. It recently became the deepest lake in Iceland, at over 248 meters and it is considered as one of the natural wonders of Iceland. It appears as "a ghostly procession of luminous blue icebergs".
- Diamond Beach is a strip of black sand belonging to the greater Breiðamerkursandur glacial plain, located by the Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon. As the icebergs in the lagoon melt, they drift out to sea, with many then washing up on the shore. This is a magnificent place for both sunset and sunrise, as the light works its magic through the ice.
- Myrdalsjokull Hike To The Glacier is only about 30 minute walk from our base to the glacier. We walk through the varied landscape on our way, formed by the glacier for the past thousands of years. There you will see how fast the glacier has been melting for the past 15 years.
- Barnafoss Waterfall Above Hraunfossar (lava falls) there is another famous waterfall called Barnafoss (children's fall). According to legend Barnafoss takes its name from two children who fell into the waterfall, a story about a Mother with her two young children.
- Ice Caves in Iceland are have a short lifespan but are a majestic beauty to witness. You can only visit them in winter. In the dead of winter, when everything appears as a seamless blanket of white, cathedrals of blue crystal are formed deep within the heart of Iceland's glaciers.
