TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

NOBORIBETSU

- ◆ **Noboribetsu Jigokudani** - is a spectacular, appropriately named valley just above the Noboribetsu Onsen, which displays hot steam vents, sulphurous streams and other volcanic activity.
- ◆ **Showa Shinzan** - literally means "Showa new Mountain", As it formed during the reign of Emperor Hirohito, known as the Showa period.
- ◆ **Bear Ranch** - around 100 brown bears in the park, and you could play with and feed them with the apple or cookies selling at the entrance.

SAPPORO

- ◆ **Shiroyo Koibito Park (Chocolate Factory)** - is a fantastic space based on the ideals of deliciousness, fun and stories of sweets from a bygone era. In addition to housing the Shiroyo Koibito Factory where this well-known Hokkaido Confectionery is produced the park also has a café to allow visitors to try Ishiya's Original sweets, the Cookiescrafft Studio, a toy exhibition room and the Rose Garden, the place visitors see, taste and experience here will make for truly "sweet memories"!
- ◆ **Hokkaido Shrine** - in 1989 the Meiji Emperor decided to enshrine three Shinto Deities; Sukunahikona, Ookunitama and Ookuninushi. They became the three deities of Hokkaido.
- ◆ **Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade** - approximately 1km – long arcade with around 200 shops that provide you a great shopping experience.

OTARU

- ◆ **Otaru Canal** - Rows of old warehouse built of stone stand along the canal. There is a stone-paved promenade and the old fashioned gas lamps are lit and provide a romantic atmosphere.
- ◆ **Sakaimachi Street (Music Box Museum)** - located at Sakaimachi Street, selling a wide variety of music boxes.

FURANO

- ◆ **Shikisai No Oka** - is a small town surrounded by a picturesque landscape of gently rolling hills and vast fields. The beautiful flowers and hills and scenery will relax and comfort the flower lovers.
- ◆ **Blue Pond (Aoiike)** - outside the hot spring town of Shirogane Onsen is named after its deep blue color which it owes to natural minerals dissolved in the water. The pond is part of an eruption and erosion control system that was built to prevent damage to Biei in case of an eruption by nearby Mount Tokachidake.
- ◆ **Furano Lavender Farm** - Furano's lavender fields attract large numbers of visitors to the region every summer, when the plants are in full bloom. The majority of lavender usually starts blooming in late June and reaches its peak from around mid- July to early August. Less numerous, later flowering varieties of lavender remain in bloom into mid- August.
