TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

BUSAN

- Haeundae Blue Line Park Beach Train Take a train with a retro shape, and the direction of the chairs is all facing the seaside, and you can enjoy the coastline of East Busan along the way.
- Huinnyeoul Cultural Village This is a small coastal village in Yeongdo, connected to Busan. The southern sea stretches under the cliff right in front of the village. The only village in Korea with a cliff is the Huinnyeoul Coastal Village. Feel the coastal village blended with the cliffs!
- Oryukdo Skywalk was built on Seungdumal, a border between the East and South Sea. The korean name translates to "walking in the sky", or so it's meant to feel like. This horse shoe-shaped bridge is set up against a 35m coastal cliff. With the entire bridge made of glass, you can watch the waves hit against the cliffs from under you.
- Gamcheon Culture Village "Korea's Santorini." "Korea's Machu Picchu." "Lego Village." These are the many nicknames the Busan neighborhood of Gamcheon 2-dong Village—has earned over the years.

DAMYANG

- Juknokwon (Bamboo Forest) Walking up the stone steps from the entrance of Zhulvyuan, the beautiful scenery and fresh air will make you feel relaxed and refreshed. The breeze blowing from the bamboo forest soothes the tired body of tourists and injects infinite vitality into life. Listening to the rustling of bamboo leaves, strolling in the dense bamboo forest, letting the sunlight shining through the gaps in the bamboo forest fall on the body, the warm and poetic scene is unforgettable.
- Metasequoia Road Selected as an exotic Korean beautiful road, walking along the tree-lined road will make you feel intoxicated by the exotic scenery. Passing through the green tunnel, you will have a deep understanding of why this is called the "dream drive route". Because of the dreamlike beauty here, Metasequoia Avenue won the award in the 2002 "2002 Beautiful Greenway" event sponsored by the Korea Forest Service and the Headquarters of Cultivating Life Forest Movement.

JEOLLABUK-DO

Jeonju Hanok Village - is located in the city of Jeonju and overlaps Pungnam-dong and Gyo-dong. There are 735 traditional Korean hanok houses. While the rest of city has been industrialized, Hanok Village retains its historical charms and traditions.

SEOUL

- **Deoksugung Palace -** Located at the corner of Seoul's busiest downtown intersection, Deoksugung Palace is famous for its elegant stone-wall road. It is also the only palace that sits alongside a series of Western style buildings that add to the uniqueness of the surrounding scenery.
- Coconut Box is a play lounge where visitors can relax as well as enjoy activities and a variety of artworks on display. The place is uniquely designed with 32 individual bungalows where visitors can feel like they are in a distant and exotic vacation destination. It also has entertainment facilities like a ball play pit large enough for adults and a VR gaming booth. Giant media art, NFT artworks, and the evening DJ house party make the lounge even more enjoyable.
