## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### DUNHUANG

- ◆ **Mogao Grottoes** - Mogao Grottoes are not only a pearl on the ancient Silk Road, but also a treasure trove of Chinese grotto art, commonly known as the Thousand Buddha Caves. They are the greatest cave sculptures in ancient China. Stone chiseling was done over 1600 years ago during the Former Qin Dynasty, and after a thousand years, 492 caves are still preserved today; Among them, the collection of murals and colored sculptures is the most complete and largest in the world today, and it is the most abundant ancient gallery in terms of content.
- ◆ **Mingsha Mountain and Crescent Moon Spring** - Amazing natural artistic beauty. Echoing-Sand Mountain, stepping on soft and fine sand, climbs to the top of the mountain dozens of meters high, and truly experiences the origin of the name Echoing-Sand, which is amazing. Then visit the wonder of Crescent Lake in the desert, which is surrounded by Echoing-Sand Mountain and named after its shape resembling a bay of crescent moon. Despite being surrounded by vast yellow sand and enduring strong winds for years, the water remains clear as a mirror, making it a rare and unique spring in the desert.
- ◆ **Lei Yin Temple** - Is a renowned Buddhist sacred site located at the foot of Mingsha (Echoing-Sand) Mountain in Dunhuang, Gansu Province. It is well known for its rich Silk Road cultural heritage, historical associations with eminent monks, and its picturesque natural surroundings. With a long history of establishment, the temple was once a place where distinguished monks through the ages- such as the eminent monk Xuanzang-resided and practiced. The main object of worship is a white marble Buddha statue, and the temple complex consists of five successive courtyards, including the Mountain Gate, the Hall of the Heavenly Kings, and the Mahavira Hall.

### ZHANGYE

- ◆ **Zhangye Danxia National Geopark** - Known for its colorful rock formations, it has been voted by Chinese media outlets as one of the most beautiful landforms in China. In 2009, Chinese National Geography magazine chose Zhangye Danxia as one of the "six most beautiful landforms" in China. The area has become a top tourist attraction for Zhangye.

### JIAYUGUAN

- ◆ **Jiayuguan City Tower** - The First Mighty Pass in the World - Jiayuguan is a world-renowned strategic pass at the western end of the Great Wall, and also the most well preserved pass on the Great Wall. Jiayuguan City is located between the Qilian Mountains and Heishan Mountains, with a dangerous terrain and a strategic location, guarding the throat. In 1961, it was announced by the state as one of the first batch of national key cultural relics protection units.

### JIUQUAN

- ◆ **Jiuquan Park** - Also known as Quanhu Park, is located approximately 2 kilometers east of Jiuquan City. The park is named after the Jiuquan spring within its grounds and has a history of over 2,000 years. Today, it is a comprehensive park that integrates classical garden design, a natural lake, cultural leisure, and recreational entertainment.
