## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### HAKONE

- ◆ **Oshino Hakkai** - Is a scenic spot in Japan's Fuji Five Lakes region, consisting of eight crystal-clear springs. Forming eight beautiful ponds, known as the "Eight Springs of Oshino," it stands as a local natural attraction.
- ◆ **Lake Kawaguchi** - is the northernmost of the Fuji Five Lakes and is administratively part of Fujikawaguchiko Town in Minamitsuru County in the southeastern part of Yamanashi Prefecture.

### IZU

- ◆ **Izu Shaboten Zoo** - Izu Cactus Zoo is a zoo where you can interact with 120 species of animals, including 1,500 cacti and capybaras.
- ◆ **Izukyuko Line** - Riding the Izu Sea View Train that runs along the coastline, tourists can choose to get off at a nearby station at any time and directly enjoy the beautiful scenery. Alternatively, they can sit in the panoramic seats facing the ocean and take in all the stunning views.
- ◆ **Mt. Omuro** - It is an independent mountain with an elevation of 580 meters. The mountain has a unique shape, resembling a large upside-down bowl, and is the symbol of the Izu Plateau. Mount Omuro was formed by a volcanic eruption about 4,000 years ago and is a nationally designated natural monument. It is also the largest cinder cone in the eastern Izu volcanic group.

### TOKYO

- ◆ **Shibuya** - Is one of Tokyo's iconic sights, and has appeared countless times in movies, magazines, and blogs. During the busiest hours, around 1,000 to 2,500 people cross the intersection every 2 minutes, enough to quickly fill a football field.
- ◆ **Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple)** - The temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.
- ◆ **Shinjuku** - Centered around the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building and a street lined with skyscrapers and office buildings, Shinjuku is known for its shopping and entertainment facilities. At its heart lies Kabukicho, renowned as the city that never sleeps, making it one of Japan's rare entertainment districts.
- ◆ **Kichijoji Petit Village** - Is a theme park inspired by the world depicted in comic books. The park features various shops, creating a cute and unique atmosphere. The largest building, "Temari no Shiro" (City of Temari), is a cat café. Inside, many cats live freely, and guests can interact with the adorable cats and enjoy a relaxing and healing time together.
