## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### GYEONGSANGNAM-DO

- ◆ **GEOJEDO Island** - is the second-largest island in South Korea, connected to Tongyeong-si by the Geojedaegyo Bridge and to Busan-si by the Geogadaegyo Bridge. It boasts numerous tourist attractions such as Haegeumgang Islets, Oedo Botania, Maemiseong Fortress, and Geoje P.O.W. Camp Historic Park. Famous for its local cuisine like sea pineapple bibimbap and sea urchin and seaweed soup, Geojedo Island is also known for its pebble beaches including Hakdong, Yeocho, Mangchi, and Nongso Pebblehaebyeon Beach.
- ◆ **OEDO Botania** - O edo is known for its magnificent terrace landscaping line and its scenic view of the crystal blue South Sea.
- ◆ **Windy Hill** - Filmed in a number of K-Dramas such as <Eve's Garden> and <Merry-Go-Round>, the windy hill is known for its iconic windmill and scenery overlooking to the sea.

### BUSAN

- ◆ **Haeundae Blueline Park Sky Capsule (4 persons per capsule)** - Is a charming, slow-paced, 4-seater automated capsule ride on an elevated track (7-10m high) along Busan's coast, unobstructed views of Haeundae Beach and the ocean, perfect for couples or families seeking a unique, scenic, photo-friendly experience above the seaside park.
- ◆ **Yonggung Temple** - It is a Buddhist temple located in Gijang County, Busan, South Korea. It is the only Buddhist temple built on the seaside in South Korea. The Buddhist temple was built in 1376 by Master Lanweng, the king's teacher during the reign of King Gongmin of Goryeo.

### POHANG

- ◆ **Homigot Sunrise Square** - Located at the easternmost tip of Pohang, it is famous for its stunning sunrise over the East Sea. The plaza features the iconic "Hands of Harmony" sculpture: one rising from the sea and the other from the land, symbolizing unity and coexistence; a must-see for travelers and photographers.

### ULSAN

- ◆ **Daewangam Park** - Located at the end of the most tapering part of the southeastern tip of South Korea heading toward the East Sea, is also famous for the Ulche navigation route signpost that guides navigation in the East Sea. There is a 600m shady pine forest trail from the park entrance to the lighthouse. Leaving the pine forest, the coastal cliffs that come into view are like dinosaur fossils from prehistoric times standing in front of the blue sea, and the huge rocks that give people an illusion are gathered here. The red rocks form a sharp contrast with the deep blue East Sea.
- ◆ **Jangsaengpo Whale Culture Village** - Recreates the former whaling village with attractions like Whale Square, Nostalgic Village, Prehistoric Whale Zone, Whale Sculpture Park, and Aquatic Plant Garden. Visitors can see life-sized whale sculptures, learn about whales, enjoy themed photo areas, and view rock carvings and whaling murals.
- ◆ **Cape Ganjeolgot Somang-gil (Hope Mailbox)** - A giant, actually usable postbox located at Ganjeolgot, a symbol of "hope." Visitors can write down their wishes and drop them in, signifying sending their hopes out. It is a popular tourist attraction in the area.

### GYEONGJU

- ◆ **Gyocheon Traditional Village** - Is a famous traditional Korean house village and historical and cultural scenic area that showcases the lifestyle, architectural style and customs of ancient Korea, especially the Joseon Dynasty and Silla culture.
- ◆ **Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond** - Located in Gyeongju, South Korea, is the site of the royal palace of the Silla Dynasty. Originally the residence of the crown prince and an artificial garden, it is famous for its dreamlike night view. As night falls, stroll through Gyeongju's most enchanting attractions – Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond, and Woljeong Bridge – and immerse yourself in timeless beauty.
- ◆ **Gyeongju Hwangnidan Street** - A street transformed from traditional Korean houses and old buildings from the 1960s and 70s, is home to restaurants, cafes, photo studios and shops, with a strong retro style that is very popular among young people.
- ◆ **Bulguksa Temple** - Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1995, Bulguksa Temple is renowned as the most exquisite Buddhist temple in Korea and is one of the few temples that has maintained a continuous flow of worshippers to this day.
