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Perth 5D4N Extravaganza Tour

TOUR CODE: 5DPERETVAL (Validity: 01 April 2026 to 31 March 2027)
DAY 1: KUALA LUMPUR → PERTH
Welcome to Perth International Airport . Upon arrival, take the airport shuttle transfer (Seat-in coach) to your selected hotel for check in. After check-in, free time at your own leisure and expense.
DAY 2: PERTH (Breakfast)
After breakfast at hotel, Join a Half Day Morning Perth & Fremantle City Explorer Tour (PF-Tue, Wed, Fri & Sun) . A great taster tour taking in Perth and Fremantle, affording the opportunity to drive around these iconic cities with various stops. Starting in Perth, the tour takes in all major attractions of the revitalised Perth CBD, passing Western Australian Cricket Ground (WACA) and Optus Stadium. Then on to Kings Park Botanical Gardens, where you have the opportunity to view wildflowers or take in the stunning views from the war memorial looking back over the city skyline. Continue through the affluent Western Suburbs of Perth, known as Millionaire's Row, passing by Cottesloe Beach where the Indian Ocean sparkles. Travel on into historic Fremantle, viewing the impressive facades of this heritage listed city including a brief stop. Depart: 0800. Return: 1230. (approximately) Pick up available at selected hotel. No Drop-off. This tour terminates at Barrack Street Jetty in Perth

DAY 3: PERTH (Breakfast)
After breakfast at hotel, select to join one of the below day tour. ((A) 4WD Pinnacles, Koalas & Sand Boarding includes Picnic Lunch (P3-Mon, Wed, Thu, Fri & Sun) This tour is not suitable for pregnant women, people with back problems or infants. Our first stop is Caversham Wildlife Park in the Swan Valley to view and take pictures with koalas and wombats as well as having the opportunity to hand feed the kangaroos. We then travel up the Indian Ocean Drive to the lobster fishing town of Cervantes. Once here, enjoy the coastal scenery and an included fish and chips lunch. After lunch, we continue north to Nambung National Park to see the mystical Pinnacle Desert for an easy-paced walk through the fascinating landscape, giving you the opportunity to really embrace this amazing and mystical place. Then it's onwards along quiet back roads to Lancelin, a stunning coastal fishing town, famous for its impressive dunes. One of the highlights of the tour involves 4-wheel driving over the vast sand dunes, the largest in Western Australia, in custom-built vehicles unique to Australian Pinnacle Tours. This is followed by the thrilling experience of downhill sand boarding over these constantly moving dunes. Delays may occasionally occur due to soft sand dunes. After an amazing day with the Pinnacle Desert, 4WD and sand boarding specialists, return to Perth down the Indian Ocean Drive. Depart: 0800. Return: 1930. (approx.) Pick up and Drop off: Available at selected hotel.


(B) Wave Rock, York & Aboriginal Culture include a Picnic Lunch. (WR-Tue, Wed, Fri & Sun)

Journey through Western Australia's wheatbelt to Hyden – home of Wave Rock, truly one of Australia's most incredible natural landforms. Leaving Perth we head through the Perth Hills and escarpment and enter farming country. Heading east, we enjoy morning tea (own expense) at historic York, the first township founded in the Avon Valley. From there we travel the Wheatbelt Highway through the agricultural towns of Corrigin and Kondinin, through outback farming country. We are given a glimpse of Australian country life on passing by the infamous Dog Cemetery, a shrine to man's best friend and an integral part of farming life.



Then visit Hippo's Yawn, a rock formation which resembles a hippo yawning. We then break for an Aussie country style lunch at the Wildflower Shop. Whilst here, visit either a Wildlife Park, view a unique Antique Lace Collection – even featuring lace from Lady Diana, or visit the amazing Toy Soldier Museum. Then we move on to see the spectacular prehistoric rock formation of Wave Rock and sacred Aboriginal sites. Leaving Wave Rock we visit Mulka's Cave. We return to Perth with a comfort stop on the way.

Depart: 0800.

Return: 2030. (approx.)

Pick up and Drop off: Available at selected hotel

(C) Margaret River, Busselton Jetty & Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse include a Lunch. (MR-Mon, Tue, Thu & Sat)

We travel south from Perth driving through farmland with grazing cattle and passing by coastal towns. Arriving at Busselton, known as the gateway to the Margaret River Region we stop for morning tea (own expense) at the iconic Busselton Jetty, the longest timber jetty in the southern hemisphere. (please note there is not enough time at this stop to walk the full length of the jetty).



Driving into the heart of the region, we head to one of Margaret River's boutique breweries for lunch (venue may change due to force majeure) with complimentary beer and cider tastings. Before lunch, we sample some local wines.

Next it's on to Mammoth Cave for a guided tour through this gothic cave with vast chambers that reveal fascinating information on the region's flora and fauna. Continuing south, through the Boranup Forest of enormous Karri Trees, we reach the most fascinating part of the region at Augusta. Here at Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse, marvel at the dividing point between the Southern and Indian oceans, a rare phenomenon to view the meetings of the two Oceans.

Then we head north up to the township of Margaret River for a brief stop to stroll the main street. After a long but fantastic day giving you a full taste of this wonderful region, it's back to Perth with an en-route comfort stop.

Depart: 0800.

Return: 2030. (approx.)

Pick up and Drop off: Available at selected hotel.



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**(D) Pinnacles, New Norcia and Benedictine History (Wildflowers in season) include a lunch.
(NN-P Dec-May: Mon / Aug-Nov: Mon & Thu)**

Travelling through the Swan Valley, we arrive at New Norcia, home to Australia's only Benedictine Abbey. A little piece of Spain comes alive in this town, full of history, art and architecture.

Hear the local history before viewing the chapel and museum artefacts gifted to the monastery by Popes and Royalty of Spain. Visit the famous Benedictine Community with a guided tour of the town and main sites including the museum and art gallery where you will find extraordinary artefacts dating back to when New Norcia was an Aboriginal mission.



Next we move on to the Abbey Church; home to one of only two large Moser organs, originally crafted in Germany. This is followed by a visit to St Gertrude's College, a grand gothic style building which was originally built as a girls boarding school and opened in 1908. We then visit a produce shop selling olive oil, fruit, wine, New Norcia nut cake and breads, before enjoying a delicious lunch.

We continue on for an easy paced walk through the mystical Pinnacles Desert and see the Pinnacles from the lookout over the park. If time permits make a visit to the Pinnacles Desert Discovery Centre. Return to Perth down the Indian Ocean Drive.

Depart: 0800.

Return: 1900. (approx.)

Pick up and Drop off: Available at selected hotel.

DAY 4: PERTH (Breakfast)

After breakfast at hotel, select to join one of the below day tour as mentioned in Day 3.

- (A) 4WD Pinnacles, Koalas & Sand Boarding includes Picnic Lunch (P3)**
- (B) Wave Rock, York, Wildflowers (seasonal) & Aboriginal Culture includes Picnic Lunch (WR)**
- (C) Margaret River, Busselton Jetty & Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse & includes Lunch (MR)**
- (D) Pinnacles New Norcia and Benedictine History (Wildflowers in season) includes Lunch (NN-P)**

DAY 5: PERTH → KUALA LUMPUR (Breakfast)

After breakfast at hotel, check-out from hotel at 1000. Free time at your own leisure until the airport shuttle transfer (Seat-in coach) to **Perth International Airport** for your flight back home.
