## DOLOMITES

- **Dolomites** - A UNESCO-listed mountain range in northern Italy, renowned for its dramatic limestone peaks, breathtaking alpine scenery, charming mountain villages, and crystal-clear lakes. Highlights include the picturesque St. Magdalena Church viewpoint, the panoramic Seceda plateau, and the beautiful Lago di Misurina.

## WATTENS

- **Swarovski Kristallwelten** - Is an immersive attraction featuring the iconic "Giant" sculpture, the "Crystal Cloud" installation, and sparkling gardens. It combines art, nature, and Swarovski crystals, offering exhibitions and a store with crystal jewelry and collectibles.

## INNSBRUCK

- **Golden Roof** - Or Goldenes Dachl is a landmark structure located in the Old Town (Altstadt) section of Innsbruck, Austria. It is considered the city's most famous symbol. Completed in 1500, the roof was decorated with 2,657 fire-gilded copper tiles for Emperor Maximilian I to mark his wedding to Bianca Maria Sforza. The Emperor and his wife used the balcony to observe festivals, tournaments, and other events that took place in the square below.

## ZUGSPITZE

- **Zugspitze** - Germany's highest mountain at 2,962 metres, renowned for its breathtaking Alpine scenery. Ascend by cogwheel train and cable car to enjoy spectacular panoramic views from the summit.

## SALZBURG

- **Salzburg** - The Austrian city of Salzburg fortress of a castle located in the castle hill, the city landmark of Salzburg. Founded in 1077, one of Europe's largest medieval castle and one of the most popular attractions in Austria.
- **Mirabell Palace** - One of the main attractions. It was built about 1606 outside the medieval walls of Salzburg according to Italian and French models by the Salzburg Archbishop Wolf Dietrich. The movie "The Sound of Music," one of the viewfinder here. Mirabell Palace is a popular wedding location.

## HALLSTATT

- **Hallstatt** - A village on Lake Hallstatt's western shore in Austria's mountainous Salzkammergut region. Its 16th-century Alpine houses and alleyways are home to cafes and shops.

## MUNICH

- **BMW Welt** - Is a showcase and experience center in Munich, Germany, where visitors can explore the brand's history, innovations, and future models. It features interactive exhibits, car displays, and offers test drives of BMW vehicles. The center is also connected to the BMW Museum and the BMW Group headquarters.
- **Frauenkirche** - Or the Church of Our Dear Lady, is the biggest church in the city. The enormous Gothic-style Cathedral was completed in 1488, with the domes crowning its towers in 1525 at 99 metres in height, were finally covered with peculiar green domes.
- **Marienplatz** - Its current name owes its origins to the famous Marian Column located in the centre of the square, it was originally called Schranneplatz, or Grain Market Square, as it was the main marketplace in the Middle Ages.
- **Rathaus Glockenspiel** - Every day at 11 a.m. and 12 p.m. it chimes and re-enacts two stories from the 16th century to the amusement. It consists of 43 bells and 32 life-sized figures. The top half of the Glockenspiel tells the story of the marriage of the local Duke Wilhelm V to Renata of Lorraine. Second story: Schäfflertanz (the cooper's dance). According to myth, 1517 was a year of plague in Munich. The cooper's are said to have danced through the streets to "bring fresh vitality to fearful dispositions."
