GREEN LINE (Go South) – 7 Day Tour



[Saturday] + Paris → Lucerne (650 km)

After boarding in Paris, sit back and enjoy a scenic journey across classic French countryside en route to mountainous Switzerland. You'll pass through Basel, which is located at the point where the Swiss, French and German borders meet. Upon arrival in Lucerne, visit the centuries-old Chapel Bridge and enjoy a stroll along Lake Lucerne. Explore the charming old streets lined with boutique shops, purchase local specialties such as Swiss chocolate and souvenirs, and visit renowned watch stores to shop for famous Swiss watches.

Overnight stay in Lucerne or city nearby (There will be a longer drive this day with less time for sightseeing.)

[Sunday] Lucerne → Milan → Venice (400 km)

Head south from Lucerne through spectacular Switzerland and into northern Italy, where your first stop will be Milan, fashion capital of the world. Your orientation tour will introduce you to the city's iconic sights, including the vast **Gothic cathedral (Duomo)**. You'll also see the planet's oldest shopping mall, the 19th-century **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II**, where you can wander among the boutique shops and have lunch in one of the refined cafes. After enjoying the many delights of Milan, you'll head to another vintage Italian city: Venice.

Overnight stay in Venice Island or city nearby

[Monday] Venice → Rome (550 km)

Spend the morning in the company of a knowledgeable local guide as you explore Venice, the most magical of cities. Begin with a **waterbus ride to San Marco Island**, a memorable crossing of the lagoon that gives you a real taste of the city's charm as you approach the dreamy spires and distinctive waterside buildings. Once on the island you'll be led around some of Venice's best-known locations, beginning in the **Piazza** with the **Basilica di San Marco**, a stunning piece of Byzantine architecture. You'll also see the legendary **Bridge of Sighs**, which appears on many a postcard or picture of Venice and connects the old prison to the interrogation rooms in the **Doge's Palace**. Afterwards you'll have a chance to see some traditional Venetian craftwork at close quarters with a demonstration by **Murano glassblowers**; their exquisite creations make excellent souvenirs. Of course, the ultimate Venice activity is to ride through the warren of waterways on a **gondola**, and for most people this optional excursion is a must. Step on board, relax and enjoy this once-in-a-lifetime experience. Afterwards, you can wander through the ancient winding alleys, and visit nostalgic cafes or restaurants to enjoy a variety of delicious foods. Transfer to Rome in the afternoon.

Overnight stay in Rome or city nearby

[Tuesday] + Rome → Vatican → Arezzo (280 km)

In the morning, depart to visit Rome's famous landmarks, including the Arch of Constantine and the magnificent Victor Emmanuel II Monument. Then continue to Vatican City—one of the smallest countries in the world—where you will visit St. Peter's Basilica, the world's largest church. Built during the European Renaissance, this masterpiece brings together the finest achievements of Italy's greatest architects and artists and took 120 years to complete. Its perfectly designed dome and the grand, solemn square are truly breathtaking. Inside the basilica, you can see the tomb of St. Peter, and Michelangelo's renowned sculpture **Pietà**—the only work he ever signed—remains housed within the church. In the afternoon, depart for Florence, known as the cradle of culture.

Overnight stay in Arezzo or city nearby

[Wednesday] Arezzo → Florence → Pisa → Genoa nearby city (250 km)

Your voyage of cultural discovery continues as you get to know Florence, the birthplace of the Italian Renaissance and home to some fabulous architecture and fine art. Begin the day by taking in a wonderful panoramic overview of the city from **Piazzale Michelangelo**, which boasts glorious vistas over the red roofs, **Arno River** and ancient city walls out towards the surrounding countryside. Next you can see a demonstration of the traditional craft of leather working at close quarters in a local workshop, and you'll also have the opportunity to purchase some of the high-quality leather items for which the city is famous. From here you'll enjoy a guided walk around Florence's many highlights, including **the Ponte Vecchio** over the Arno, the **Piazza del Duomo** and **Campanile Tower**. You'll pass the **Uffizi Gallery**, which contains one of the most notable art collections in Florence. You'll have free time to see the city further, to shop or to watch the world go by from a street side cafe, before travelling on to your next destination, Pisa. Here you are free to wander, but be sure to have your camera ready to get a shot of the iconic **Leaning Tower**, the famous bell tower in the '**Square of Miracles**', which also contains the centuries-old Cathedral and Baptistery, after that we are transferring towards a city nearby Genoa in the late evening for stay. **Please note we will not visit the city Genoa.**

Overnight stay in Genoa or city nearby

[Thursday] Genoa nearby city → Monaco → Nice → Cannes → Avignon or nearby city (450 km)

In the morning, we will depart for the French Riviera in the south of France. Around noon, we will arrive in the small country of Monaco. Monte Carlo, a picturesque city between the mountains and the sea, is a glamorous destination and a paradise for the world's wealthy. We will visit the **Monaco Royal Palace** and enjoy breathtaking views of the country from the hilltops. The south of France is known for its perfume production, and along the way, we will stop in a perfume-producing town to visit a perfume factory, where participants can choose their favorite scents.

Next, we will head to the leisure resort city of Nice, where we will explore the **Promenade des Anglais** and the **Bay of Angels**. Afterward, we will drive to Cannes, famous for its international film festival, where participants can take photos at the festival venue and walk along the star-studded avenue marked with handprints of world-renowned celebrities. In the afternoon, we will leave the French Riviera and head to the hotel near Avignon for our overnight stay. **Please note we will not visit the city Avignon.**

Overnight stay in Avignon or city nearby

[Friday] Avignon or nearby city → Dijon (add in Apr 2026) →Paris + 🚗 (700 km)

Depart in the morning for Dijon, arriving around noon (add in Apr 2026). Since the early 11th century, Dijon has been the capital of the Burgundy region, known as the "Capital of the Dukes of Burgundy" for its well-preserved monuments. Its tranquility and simplicity are enchanting, and strolling among the ancient medieval architecture leaves visitors reluctant to depart. Highlights to visit include: the Palace of the Dukes and Estates of Burgundy (the Fine Arts Museum), Notre Dame, Liberty Street, Guillaume Gate (nicknamed the "Little Arc de Triomphe"), and the François Rude Square. You may also enjoy a glass of Burgundy wine to experience the proud local wine culture. In the afternoon, continue via highway to Paris, with an expected arrival at dusk.

Overnight stay in Paris or city nearby (Longer drive this day. Starting in April, a visit to Dijon will be added.)

In Apr 2026, the Green Line itinerary adds a visit to Dijon; the 2025 itinerary remains unchanged, departing in the morning directly for Paris without visiting Dijon.
