TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

NOBORIBETSU

- ◆ **Noboribetsu Jogoikudani** - Is a spectacular, appropriately named valley just above the Noboribetsu Onsen, which displays hot steam vents, sulphurous streams and other volcanic activity.
- ◆ **Showan Shinzan** - Literally means "Showa new Mountain", as it formed during the reign of Emperor Hirohito, known as the Showa period.

OTARU

- ◆ **Otaru Canal** - Rows of old warehouse built of stone stand along the canal. There is a stone-paved promenade and the old fashioned gas lamps are lit and provide a romantic atmosphere.
- ◆ **Music Box Museum** - Located at Sakaimachi Street, selling a wide variety of music boxes.
- ◆ **Sakaimachi Street** - Is an attractive, preserved merchant street in central Otaru, and famous with Kitaichi Glass and Music Box Museum.

SAPPORO

- ◆ **Hill of the Buddha** - Designed by top Japanese architect Tadao Ando, this photogenic Buddha statue in a hall exudes spirituality. In keeping with Ando's mindset that "our imagination is piqued by what we cannot see," only the head is visible from a distance, prompting you to spend your trip to the site imagining what the rest might look like. Your appetite is whet with other sensory experiences along the way, including a water garden and a 40m tunnel that amplifies the sound of your footsteps. Finally, you reach a roofless hall where the 13.5m high Buddha looms over you with a snippet of sky above. This ethereal sight isn't one you'll forget easily. While you're here, you can take part in Japanese spiritual practices—write a wish on a wooden placard called an ema, find out your fortune by taking a slip of paper called an omikuji and make message lighting to express a wish. After your visit, take a moment to rest in the café in the hall.
- ◆ **Mount Moiwa (Included Cable Car)** - Is recognized as one of Japan's "New Three Great Night Views" and is one of Sapporo's most iconic scenic spots. As the last glow of sunset fades, the city lights gradually begin to sparkle like a sea of stars, filling the entire city with a romantic atmosphere. From the summit observatory, visitors can enjoy a breathtaking 360-degree panoramic view of Sapporo, offering an unforgettable visual experience of the illuminated cityscape.
- ◆ **Hokkaido Shrine** - In 1869 the Meiji Emperor decided to enshrine three Shinto Deities: Sukunahikona, Ookunitama and Ookuninushi. They became the three deities of Hokkaido. The building for the shrine was built in 1871 and was called "Sapporo Shrine".
- ◆ **Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade** - Approximately 1km - long arcade with around 200 shops that provide you a great shopping experience.
