TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

NOBORIBETSU

- ◆ **Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura** - A history theme park highlighting the Edo Period, one of the most attractive era in Japanese history. Step back in time to enjoy traditional games, activities, theaters, street performances and more. The charm of ancient Japan is abundant as you mingle with the Ninja and Oiran courtesans so symbolic of the Edo Period.
- ◆ **Noboribetsu Jigokudani** - Is a spectacular, appropriately named valley just above the town of Noboribetsu Onsen, which displays hot steam vents, sulfurous streams and other volcanic activity.
- ◆ **Mt. Showa-Shinzan** - literally means 'Showa new mountain', as it formed during the reign of Emperor Hirohito, known as the Showa period.
- ◆ **Noboribetsu Marine Park Nixe** - Is a popular theme park focusing on fish, marine mammals, sea creatures and some other animals. More attractions include a touch pool with small sharks, rays, and horseshoe crabs; a reptile house with snakes, turtles and lizards. You may also have fun activities and small events like the Parade of the king penguins (Subject to weather conditions).

OTARU

- ◆ **Otaru Canal** - Rows of old warehouse built of stone stand along the canal. There is a stone-paved promenade and the old-fashioned gas lamps are lit and provide a romantic atmosphere.
- ◆ **Sakaimachi Street** - Is an attractive, preserved merchant street in central Otaru, and famous with Kitaichi Glass and Music Box Museum.

SAPPORO

- ◆ **Shiroi Koibito Park** - Is a fantastic space based on the ideals of deliciousness, fun and stories of sweets from a by gone era. In addition to housing the Shiroi Koibito Factory where this well-known Hokkaido confectionery is produced, the park also has a cafe to allow visitors to try Ishiya's original sweets, the Cokkiecraft Studio, a toy exhibition room and the Rose Garden. The place visitors see, taste and experience here will make for truly "sweet" memories!
- ◆ **Hokkaido Shrine** - In 1869 the Meiji Emperor decided to enshrine three Shinto Deities: Sukunahikona, Ookunitama and Ookuninushi. They became the three deities of Hokkaido. The building for the shrine was built in 1871 and was called "Sapporo Shrine".
- ◆ **Tanukikoji Shopping Arcade** - Approximately 1km - long arcade with around 200 shops that provide you a great shopping experience.
- ◆ **Mt. Moiwa (Included Cable Car)** - Is recognized as one of Japan's "New Three Great Night Views" and is one of Sapporo's most iconic scenic spots. As the last glow of sunset fades, the city lights gradually begin to sparkle like a sea of stars, filling the entire city with a romantic atmosphere. From the summit observatory, visitors can enjoy a breathtaking 360-degree panoramic view of Sapporo, offering an unforgettable visual experience of the illuminated cityscape.
