## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### TAICHUNG

- ◆ **ABAS Distillery Story Hall** - Visitors can learn about the traditional solid-state pure grain distillation process through guided tours and discover how it differs from modern liquor production methods. Guests can also join a tasting experience and explore the five steps of liquor appreciation, gaining a deeper understanding of the different layers and characteristics of various spirits while enjoying carefully paired snacks that enhance the tasting experience.
- ◆ **Dajia Jenn Lann Temple** - Located in Dajia District, Taichung, Dajia Jenn Lann Temple, commonly known as the Dajia Mazu Temple, is one of Taiwan's most important temples dedicated to Mazu, the Goddess of the Sea. The annual Dajia Mazu Pilgrimage is one of the largest and most significant religious events in Taiwan and has been recognized as an important folk cultural heritage of the Republic of China (Taiwan).

### MIAOLI

- ◆ **Flower Home Leisure Farm** - Once the site of a Japanese Zero Fighter airfield, Flower Home Leisure Farm has been transformed into a beautiful floral paradise surrounded by swaying tung trees and tea plantations. Famous for its fragrant lavender and rosemary gardens, the farm attracts numerous visitors from January to April each year, when its expansive lavender fields are in full bloom.

### TAIPEI

- ◆ **Heping Island GeoPark** - Formerly known as Sheliiao Island, Heping Island is situated northeast of Keelung and serves as the gateway to Keelung Harbor. It was one of the earliest locations in Northern Taiwan visited by Westerners and one of the first areas settled by Han Chinese. Originally inhabited by the Ketagalan people, the island was later designated as a military control zone. Today, part of its coastline has been opened to the public as Heping Island Geopark.
- ◆ **CKS Shilin Residence** - The Shilin Residence Garden consists of the Outer Garden, Inner Garden, Main Residence, Orchid Greenhouse, Rose Garden, Victory Chapel, Xinlanting Pavilion, and Ciyun Pavilion. The Inner Garden features a traditional Chinese landscape design with winding streams, elegant bridges, rockeries, unusual stones, and a classic red pavilion. In contrast, the Outer Garden showcases a Western-style landscape with beautifully designed flower beds and seasonal blooms.
- ◆ **Shifen Old Street** - Is one of the oldest and largest settlements along the historic Pingxi Railway Line, originally built to support coal mining operations. Today, the old street is famous for its unique setting alongside active railway tracks, where visitors can experience the thrill of trains passing just steps away. The area is also known for sky lantern activities and has served as a popular filming location for movies and television dramas.
- ◆ **Ningxia Night Market** - Is one of Taipei's most traditional and beloved night markets. From classic Taiwanese snacks and regional specialties to innovative street food, the market offers an impressive variety of culinary delights. Its concentration of famous food stalls has earned it a reputation as one of Taipei's premier destinations for authentic local cuisine.
