TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

- ◆ **Sensoji (Asakusa Kanon Temple)** - Is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kanon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.

MT. FUJI

- ◆ **Mt. Fuji 5th Station** - At 2300 meters above sea level, the Fuji Subaru Line 5th Station offers a commanding view of the Fuji Five Lakes area below, making it a popular spot even for those who are not intent on climbing the mountain.

IZU

- ◆ **Mt. Omuro** - Is one of the most iconic landmarks in the Izu region, located in Ito City, Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan. Its unique shape resembles a giant matcha pudding, which is why it is often nicknamed the "Matcha Mountain."

SHIZUOKA

- ◆ **Mishima Skywalk** - Is Japan's longest pedestrian suspension bridge, stretching 400 meters across a scenic valley. Opened in 2015, the bridge offers breathtaking panoramic views of Mount Fuji, Suruga Bay, and the surrounding lush forests. As visitors walk across the bridge, they can enjoy stunning natural scenery throughout the year, from vibrant greenery in summer to colorful autumn foliage. The site also features various outdoor activities, souvenir shops, and local food stalls, making it a popular attraction in Shizuoka Prefecture.

GIFU

- ◆ **Ena Gorge Observatory** - One of the best viewpoints for admiring the spectacular natural scenery of Ena Gorge. Located in Ena City, Gifu Prefecture, the gorge is famous for its beautiful lake and canyon landscape formed after the construction of the Oi Dam on the Kiso River. From the observatory, visitors can enjoy panoramic views of the tranquil waters of Ena Gorge, surrounded by dramatic rock formations, lush mountains, and picturesque valleys. The unique cliffs and oddly shaped rocks along the riverbanks create a stunning contrast against the crystal-clear water. Each season offers its own charm: cherry blossoms in spring, vibrant greenery in summer, colorful foliage in autumn, and peaceful snowy scenery in winter. As one of Central Japan's most renowned scenic destinations, Ena Gorge is a perfect place to experience the beauty of nature throughout the year.

NAGANO

- ◆ **Tsumago-juku** - is an old post town built during the Edo period on the historic Nakasendo road. It was a rest stop for travelers, samurai, and merchants between Tokyo and Kyoto. Today, it is very well preserved and not a reconstructed street. Walking here feels like going back over 300 years to old Japan.
