TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

BUSAN

- ◆ **Haeundae Dalmaji Road** - the road famous of take photo & soak in the cherry blossom atmosphere.
- ◆ **Huinnyeoul Culture Village** - This is a small coastal village in Yeongdo, connected to Busan. The southern sea stretches under the cliff right in front of the village. The only village in Korea with a cliff is the Huinnyeoul Coastal Village. Feel the coastal village blended with the cliffs!
- ◆ **Haeundae Blue Line Park Beach Train** - Take a train with a retro shape, and the direction of the chairs is all facing the seaside, and you can enjoy the coastline of East Busan along the way.
- ◆ **Yonggung Temple** - was first built in 1376 by the great Buddhist teacher known as Naong during the Goryeo Dynasty.

POHANG

- ◆ **Pohang Space Walk** - Space Walk is a trekking trail 333 meters high with 717 steps in total. Visitors can enjoy a 360 degree panoramic view of the city and factories, and its highest point reaches 25m up into the sky. Located on the hills of Hwanho Park in Pohang. Incredible Winding Staircase That Looks Like a Roller Coaster in South Korea.

JINHAЕ

- ◆ **Jinhae Sakura Festival** - will be held in the area of Jungwon Rotary and downtown Jinhae with splendid cherry blossoms. Varied programs including a pre-event, cultural performances, a military performance, and others will take place during the festival.
- ◆ **Gyeonghwa Station** - famous spot for cherry blossom, is a small railway station in Gyeonghwa-dong, Jinhae-gu. You can walk through the tracks surround by rows of cherry blossom trees, making a tunnel effect filled with flowers and is one of the top three spots in Jinhae for taking photos of the cherry blossoms.
- ◆ **Yejowacheon Bridge** - The area around Yeojwacheon Stream is well known as one of Jinhae's best spots for viewing cherry blossoms. The bridge instantly became popular and widely known as the Romance Bridge. Each April, the entire city of Jinhae is filled with cherry blossoms, but the Yeojwacheon Stream area has the most beautiful cherry blossoms which makes it a prime tourist attraction.

DAEGU

- ◆ **Seomun Market (Closed on first and third Sunday of every month)** - Seomun Market was one of the three main markets during the Joseon dynasty. The specialties of the current Seomun Market include fabric-related items like silk, satin, linen, cotton, knitted goods, and clothing. The signature dish of Seomun Night Market is Cup Makchang, small servings of Korea's soul food makchang (beef intestines). Other popular dishes include mu teokbokki, a unique take on a classic Korean dish with thinly sliced radish, and a remake of British fare shrimp and chips.
- ◆ **Starbucks Daegu Jongro Goteak** - A New Stunning Hanok-Style Outlet. A gorgeous hanok complete with giwa roofing, luxurious parquet flooring, exposed beams and traditional wall paintings.

SUWON

- ◆ **Yonggeonneung** - is a burial ground from the Joseon dynasty, located within an oak-forested park in Hwaseong, South Korea. Yongneung is the tomb of Crown Prince Sado and Lady Hyegyong (posthumously honored as King Jangjo and Queen Heongyeong), while Geonneung houses King Jeongjo and Queen Hyoui. They are an UNESCO World Heritage Site.

SEOUL

- ◆ **The Lotte World Tower** - the nation's tallest and the world's fifth tallest building. The observatory offers a panoramic view of the entire capital city, beautiful both day and night. SEOUL SKY is comprised of an exhibition zone, observation deck, sky deck, dessert cafe, sky terrace, lounge, and more.
