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Osaka 6D5N Takayama-Shirakawago - Kyoto Train & Bus Tour

DAY 1: KUALA LUMPUR → OSAKA (Kansai International Airport)

Welcome to **Kansai International Airport**, Osaka.
Meet by "greeting staff" as you exit out of the arrival hall. Then transfer to the hotel by van service.

Free and easy at your own leisure time.

Overnight at hotel in Osaka.



DAY 2: OSAKA ➤ TAKAYAMA

Early morning train from JR Osaka Station to JR Takayama Station.
(Own expenses to JR Osaka Station. Info will be provided).
(Return train tickets included for this itinerary and subject to seats availability basis).

(Inter-cities travel information by train will be provided).

On arrival at JR Takayama Station, walk across the road to the hotel of stay. .

Rest of the day is free at your leisure time & expense.

On your own, explore Takayama, set amid the northern Alps in central Japan.

Known as the roof of Japan. The old streets are lined with traditional homes and many of them constructed 400 years ago. Known as "little Kyoto" and boasts a unique culture that fuses Kyoto and the Edo traditions.

Overnight in Takayama hotel.



DAY 3: TAKAYAMA ➤ SHIRAKAWAGO ➤ TAKAYAMA

In the morning, walk to the bus terminal (own arrangement) and join the **Shirakawago & Ainokura Bus Tour**.

(Japanese speaking bus attendants will accompany the bus).

0830: Depart from Takayama Bus Terminal.

➤ **Gokayama Ainokura Village.** (Stoll around on your own).

Most of the gassho style houses, traditional thatched roof houses were built about 100-200 years ago during the Edo & Meiji Period.

➤ **Shirakawago Village.** (Stoll around on your own).

Shirakawago is situated at the foot of Mt.Hakusan. It's a quite mountains village with rice field and a river running through it. Traditional thatched roof stand together in the village. You can see the beautiful landscape here.

The tour includes an admission ticket to "Gasshozukuri Minkaen Outdoor Museum" in Shirakawago, and a shuttle bus ticket to "Tenshukaku Observation Deck". From December to March, "Gassho Zukuri Minkaen Museum" is closed every Thursday.

1500: Depart from Sihrakawago Bus Terminal.

1550: Arrive at Takayaama Bus Termnal. (Walk back to the hotel, own arrangement).

Overnight in Takayama hotel.



DAY 4: TAKAYAMA ➤ OSAKA

Check-out of Takayama hotel. Morning, free & easy, walk to the Miyagawa Morning Market at your own leisure time and expense. In the afternoon travel back to Osaka on the afternoon train. On arrival in JR Osaka Station, proceed to the Osaka hotel at your own expenses. (Info will be provided).

Rest of the day is free at your leisure time and expense.

Overnight in Osaka hotel.





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DAY 5: OSAKA ➤ KYOTO ➤ OSAKA (LUNCH)

Today join the **Kyoto Highlights Tour (Daily)**

Proceed to meeting point & return to hotel on your own arrangement/expenses. (Info will be provided).

- Arashiyama (120 mins)
(include lunch time).
- Kinkakuji Temple (45 mins).
- Kiyomizudera Temple (70 mins).
