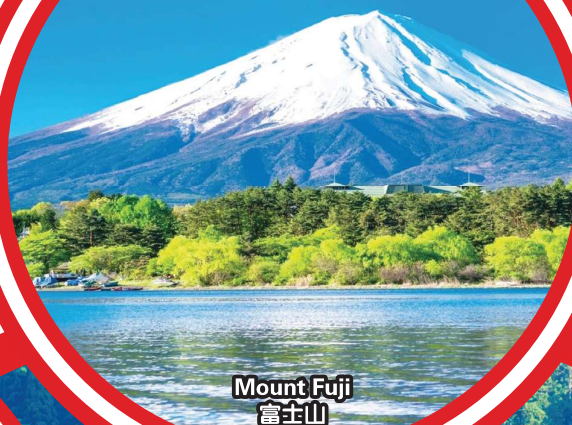

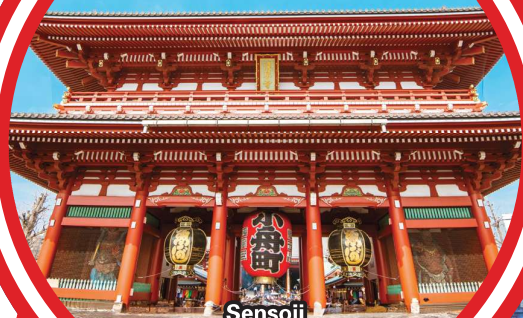

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

TOKYO

- ◆ **Sensoji (also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple)** - Is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kannon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along Nakamise Shopping Arcade, is bustling with people buying traditional Japanese snacks, which you could see many snack stalls demonstrate how they make it and then sell it still piping hot.

HAKONE

- ◆ **Mt. Fuji 5th Station** - At 3776 meters above sea level, the Fuji Subaru Line 5th Station offers a commanding view of the Fuji Five Lakes area below, making it a popular spot even for those who are not intent on climbing the mountain.

MATSUMOTO

- ◆ **Matsumoto Castle** - Is one of Japan's premier historic castles, along with Himeji and Kumamoto.

TAKAYAMA

- ◆ **Takayama Old Town** - Alpine Streets retaining the traditional Japanese style, walking in the Edo period in Japan among the primary building ancient taste, elegant and quiet atmosphere, showing the traditional beauty of Japanese culture, the alpine region's most popular tourist attractions.

SHIRAKAWA-GO

- ◆ **Shirakawa-go Village** - The Historic Villages of Shirakawa-gō are one of Japan's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These villages are well known for their houses constructed in the architectural style known as gashō-zukuri. The Gasshō-zukuri, "prayer-hands construction" style is characterized by a thatched and steeply slanting roof resembling two hands joined in prayer. The design is exceptionally strong and, in combination with the unique properties of the thatching, allow the houses to withstand and shed the weight of the region's heavy snowfalls in winter.

KYOTO

- ◆ **Fushimi Inari Shrine** - Is an important Shinto shrine in southern Kyoto. It is famous for its thousands of vermillion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails behind its main buildings. Fushimi Inari is the most important of several thousands of shrines dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice. Foxes are thought to be Inari's messengers, resulting in many fox statues across the shrine grounds.

OSAKA

- ◆ **Shinsaibashi Shopping Arcade** - A bustling shopping street filled with interesting shops and restaurants.
